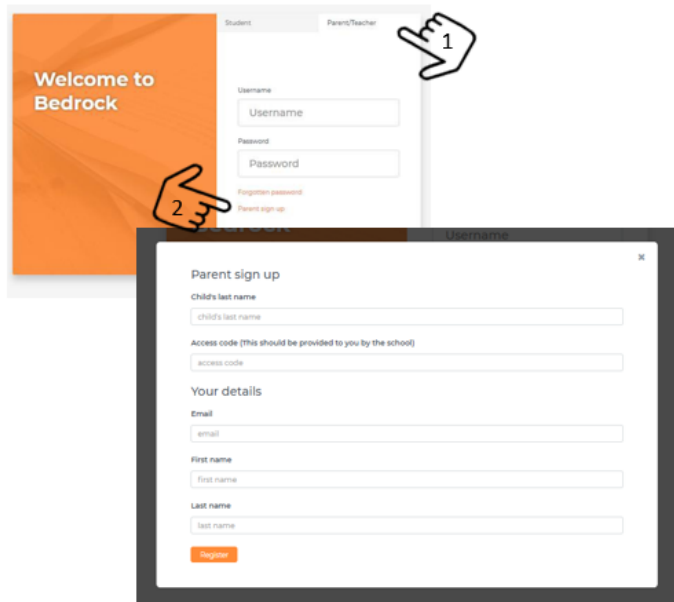

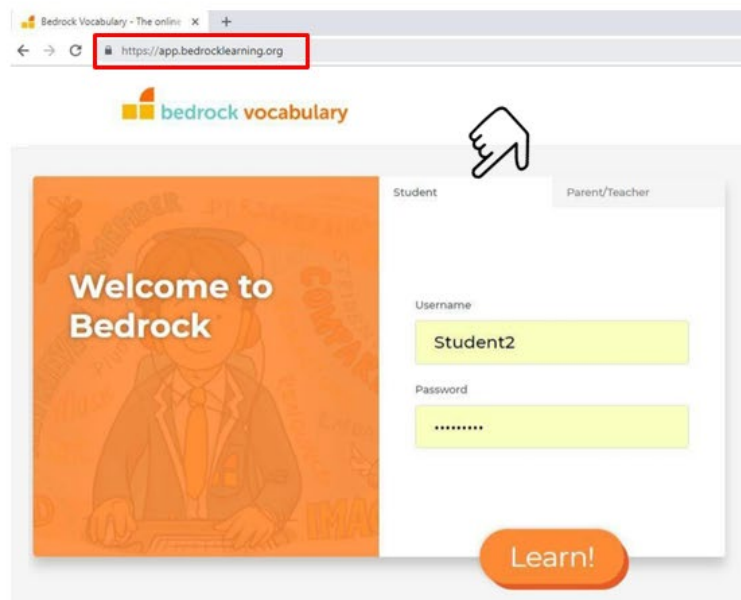
- 1) Go to showmyhomework.co.uk/signup or open the mobile app.
- 2) Click on the parent or student button.
- 3) Parents enter the code that you have been provided.
- 4) If you have already registered you can use the email that you registered with.

Bedrock English Log In



Parent Sign Up

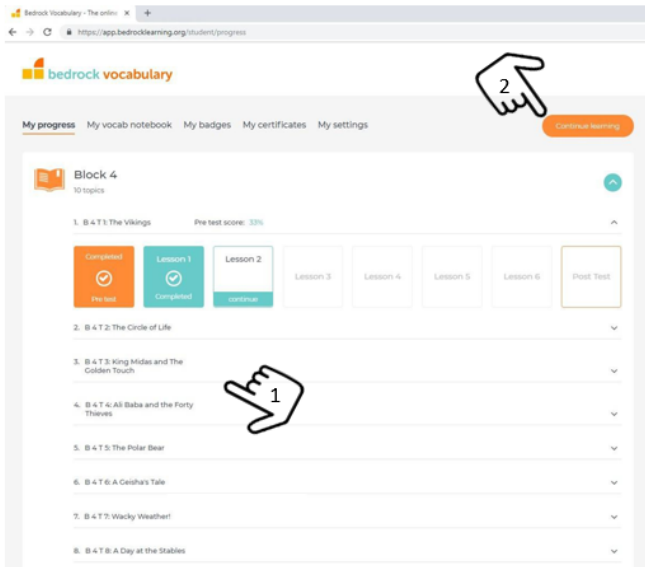
- Parent sign up is for the parents of students on Bedrock to get access to their child's progress.
- Parents can sign up to the programme in the following way:
 - 1) Click on the Parent/Teacher tab on the sign in screen.
 - 2) Click on 'Parent sign up'.
- The parent will then be shown the parent sign up form. Once they complete this form and click 'register' they will have access to the system.
- The access code is provided by the teacher and is obtained as shown in the previous slide.



Student Log in

- The student log in is accessed through the same web link as the teacher log in.
- Students need to click on the student log in tab and enter the username and password that you have provided from the download (see previous slides).
- Make sure students keep their usernames and passwords safe, they will need them each time they log in.





- When a student logs in they will see the screen opposite.
 - This is the student's dashboard, it shows a student their progress through the Bedrock programme.
- 1) The dashboard also shows the topics covered within the block that the student is currently working on and the pre test score for the student's current topic.
 - 2) To continue learning the student needs to click the 'Continue Learning' button. This will take them to the next lesson in the topic.
- The right hand of the screen (not shown opposite) will show the badges and certificates the student has been awarded, as well as the student's vocabulary notebook.

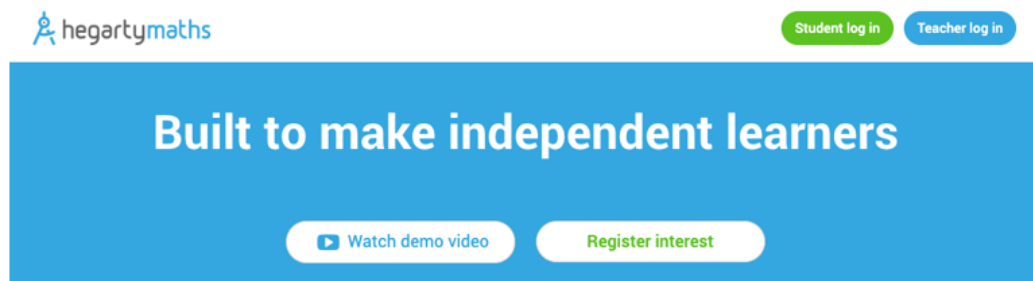
How does a student log in?

Teachers will have set up student accounts and classes on HegartyMaths in advance. To log in, follow this process:


1. Start

From the website, www.hegartymaths.com, click on "Student log in"



2. School


Find your school - start typing - your school should show in the list. You can also use the postcode of the school if that's easier.

3. Details


Enter First name, Last name and Date of birth. These must be the same as the details on the school register. Names are cAsE insEnSiTiVe, so it doesn't matter if you write them in *lower* case or *UPPER* case or a *MiX*.


4. Password

The first time you log in, the system asks you to choose a password which you will need to write twice. Create a memorable password so you do not forget it. Only a teacher can reset a student password, so choose carefully! (Maybe write it down inside the cover of your maths book?)

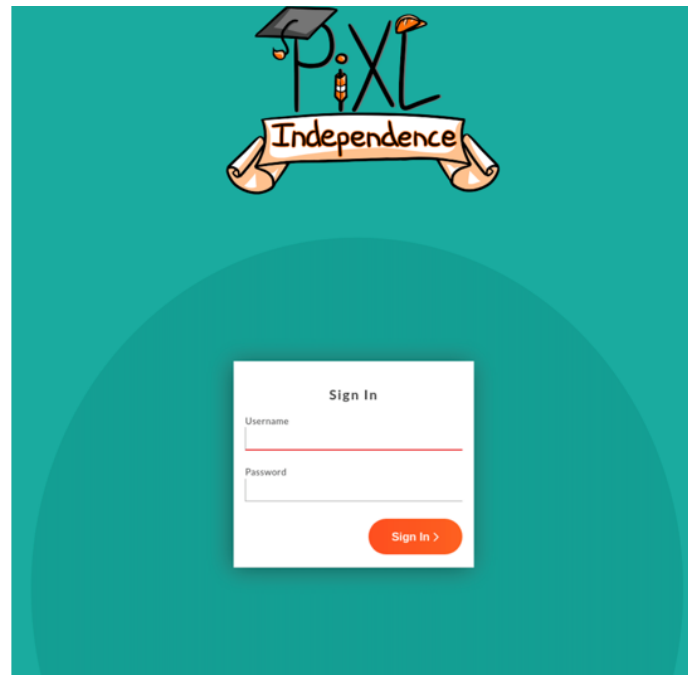
