1h and 20 minutes- you will need to write 2 essays and translate a passage in the target language.

### Germany in Transition 1919 - 39 - Duration of exam: 1 hour

Your exam will focus on the seven key questions below:

**1. Impact of the First World War:**  
What challenges were faced by the Weimar Republic from 1919-1923?

**2. Recovery of Weimar:**  
Why were the Stresemann years considered a 'golden age'?

**3. End of the Weimar Republic:**  
How and why did the Weimar Republic collapse between 1929 and 1933?

**4. Consolidation of power:**  
How did the Nazis consolidate their power between 1933 and 1934?

**5. Nazi economic, social and racial policy:**  
How did Nazi economic, social and racial policy affect life in Germany?

### The Elizabethan Age 1558 - 1603 - Duration of exam: 1 hour

Your examination will focus on the two key questions below:

**1. Elizabethan government:**  
How successful was the government of Elizabeth I?

**2. Lifestyles of rich and poor:**  
How did life differ for the rich and poor in Elizabethan times?

**3. Popular entertainment:**  
What were the most popular types of entertainment in Elizabethan times?

**4. The problem of religion:**  
How successfully did Elizabeth deal with the problem of religion?

**5. The Catholic threat:**  
Why were the Catholics such a serious threat to Elizabeth?

**6. The Spanish Armada:**  
How much of a threat was the Spanish Armada?

**7. The Puritan Threat:**  
Why did the Puritans become an increasing threat during Elizabeth's reign?
